Prepare

Invite Jesus to speak to each one of you afresh today, as you explore the events of Easter Sunday, and ask Him to bless your time together as a family.

Icebreaker

If you had to describe Easter in just three words, what words would you use?!

Engage

Reflect

What might Jesus' friends have been thinking and feeling as they locked themselves away in the upper room?

What might Jesus' friends have felt as they started to realise that their hopes were restored because Jesus was alive?

What might Thomas have been thinking when he heard the news that Jesus was alive? What must Thomas have been feeling when he saw Jesus with his own eyes?

Over 500 people saw Jesus after He rose from the dead, people's lives were transformed through their encounters with Jesus. What does it mean to you today, to know Jesus as friend and saviour?
